MEMORANDUM OPINION

Opinion by Chief Justice Burns

This appeal follows the trial court's temporary injunction order. Stating the trial court has dissolved the injunction, appellant has filed a motion to dismiss the appeal as moot. Appellee has not filed a response.

An appeal from a temporary injunction order is rendered moot, and must be dismissed, if the injunction is dissolved. *See State v. Ruiz Wholesale Co.*, 901 S.W.2d 772, 775, 778 (Tex. App.—Austin 1995, no writ).

Accordingly, we grant the motion and dismiss the appeal. *See id.* at 778.
