**MEMORANDUM OPINION**

Before Justices Whitehill, Osborne, and Carlyle  
Opinion by Justice Osborne

The filing fee, docketing statement, reporter's record, and clerk's record in this case are past due. By postcard dated February 28, 2020, we notified appellant the \$205 filing fee was due. We directed appellant to remit the filing fee within ten days and expressly cautioned appellant that failure to do so would result in dismissal of the appeal. Also by postcard dated February 28, 2020, we informed appellant the docketing statement in this case was due. We cautioned appellant that failure to file the docketing statement within ten days might result in the dismissal of this appeal without further notice. By letter dated April 23, 2020, we informed appellant the reporter's record had not been filed because appellant had not paid for the reporter's

record. We directed appellant to provide, within ten days, (1) verification of request for and payment or arrangements to pay for the reporter's record, or (2) written documentation that appellant had been found entitled to proceed without payment of costs. We cautioned appellant that failure to do so would result in the dismissal of this appeal without further notice. By letter dated April 28, 2020, we informed appellant the clerk's record had not been filed because appellant had not paid for the clerk's record. We directed appellant to provide, within ten days, (1) verification of payment or arrangements to pay for the clerk's record, or (2) written documentation that appellant had been found entitled to proceed without payment of costs. We cautioned appellant that failure to do so would result in the dismissal of this appeal without further notice. To date, appellant has not paid the filing fee, provided the required documentation, or otherwise corresponded with the Court regarding the status of this appeal.

Accordingly, we dismiss this appeal. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 37.3(b), (c); 42.3(b), (c).
